





One way of protecting your account is to use two-factor authentication. This prevents anyone who obtains your password, such as a hacker, from accessing your account, because it requires a second access code that changes constantly and is available only to you. Here's how to set up this feature:




Step 1:

From your Home page, click on the arrow. ▼




Step 2:

Select "Settings & privacy".




Step 3:

From the list of options, click on "Settings".




Step 4:


Click on "Security and login" from the list at the side.




Step 5:

Click on "Use two-factor authentication".







Step 6:

Enter your Facebook password.


Step 7:

Choose the security method you want to use to prevent anyone other than you from logging in to your account – a) Text message (SMS), or b) authentication app If you chose a), proceed as follows:

A- Click on "Use text message (SMS)", if your Facebook account is linked to your mobile phone number.


You'll receive a text message on your phone with a six-digit code – enter it in the boxes,






and it will activate twofactor authentication using text messages to receive verification codes.






B- Click on "Use text message (SMS)", if your Facebook account is linked to your mobile phone number.

having first made sure to download an app like Duo Mobile or Google Authenticator to generate verification codes.


Use the app to scan the QR code that appears on your screen.





It will show the six digits you need to use (they change roughly every 30 seconds) to protect your account from hacking attempts.


Click on "Next" on Facebook,
